## MICRA CHALLENGE 2024 – REGULATIONS

### BULLETIN 1

#### Amendment to Micra Challenge 2024 Regulations

To give an opportunity to registered competitors in the Micra Challenge to compete on an additional closed public roads event the 2024 Challenge will add the Ulster Rally as a counting round.

This follows widespread consultation with registered competitors and to minimise the impact on the Challenge:

- All existing events will continue to be counting rounds; thus, the 2024 Micra Challenge will increase from 7 to 8 rounds.
- To help competitors to stay within their budgets and for those who wish to stick to their plan for the season, the number of counting rounds will be unchanged. Therefore, the best 5 scores from 8 events will count.
- The following Regulations are affected:

#### Article 2.0 Eligible Events

1. 17th February	* Kirkistown	NI Championship
2. 9th March	* Bishopscourt	NI Championship
3. 6th May	* Mayday Stages	(SVR. St Angelo)
4. 18th May	Tour of the Sperrins	NI Championship (closed roads)
5. 20th July	Tyrone Stages	NI Championship (private roads)
6. 17th August	Ulster Rally	Irish Tarmac Championship (closed roads)
7. 7th September	Lakeland Stages	NI Forest Challenge
8. 19th October	Maiden City	NI Forest Challenge

\* Denotes events counting for the Standard Micra awards

If any of the above events fail to run on the date(s) listed above, it shall cease to be a round of this Challenge. In this case the organisers reserve the right to nominate a replacement event which will be notified to all registered competitors by email and on social media.

Organisers of qualifying events retain the sole right to select and accept entries for the event. The Challenge organisers cannot be held responsible for any competitor not getting an entry, for any reason. It is a competitor's responsibility to obtain Event Regulations and make his/her entries and it is recommended that competitors submit entries promptly.

#### Article 3.0 Scoring

For competitors to be eligible for Micra Challenge Awards the following criteria must also be noted:

- Competitors must compete on at least one of the forest-based events (Rounds 7 and 8).
- No bonus or joker points will be awarded to competitors on any round of the Challenge.

## MICRA CHALLENGE 2024 – REGULATIONS

For the purposes of Micra Challenge points, the following definition of Counting Events shall apply (except in the case of ties – see Article 6.0):

- 8 events run - 5 to count
- 7 events run - 5 to count
- 6 events run - 5 to count
- 5 events run - 4 to count
- 4 or 3 events run – All to count
- If less than 3 rounds run, there shall not be a Challenge.
